**Information Form**

Persons traveling must be able to participate in the physical activities that may be necessary on any trip. **In fairness to the other travelers, you must be able to keep up with the group on walking tours and be in full command of your faculties.** The ability to walk comfortably at an even pace is necessary.

**PHYSICAL/MENTAL LIMITATIONS**

**If you are impaired either physically or mentally, or have any serious health issues that may hamper your ability to walk with or stay up with the group (but you still wish to go on the trip), you will need to provide a personal escort for yourself and this person must pay the regular tour fee. This person will need to remain with you in the event you cannot participate fully in any specific tour. Also, if you have a tendency to lose or misplace items, i.e., airline ticket, camera, purse, etc., your personal escort will be the party responsible for working with you and us to resolve it if possible. For lost passports, your personal escort will be the party responsible for going to the American Embassy to replace it. If you would need medical care at any point related to your stated disability, your personal escort will need to stay with you and be your advocate at a healthcare facility. However, Valerie and Wayne will work with the travel agency on your behalf to support you in any crisis, as they would with any other traveler experiencing difficulties.**

**PRICING OF TRIP**

**Please read the Terms and Conditions carefully. This trip is based on the currency rate in June, 2018. In the event of a marked change in foreign exchange rates, fuel costs or tariff rates, tour costs are subject to revision. Such increases or decreases will be added to your final trip billing.**

## **DEPARTURE:**

The group will leave from **Fond du Lac, WI** on September 2, 2019. We will depart from Schreiner's Parking lot, Hwy 41/Hwy 23, Fond du Lac, WI. If *anyone wishes to meet us at O'Hare airport*, this can be arranged **but we need to know as soon as possible**. We encourage arriving the day prior to departure due to possibly missing outgoing flight. Travelers can also be picked up at a designated Park 'n Lock along I-94 between Fond du Lac and the Wisconsin border.

## **WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE PACKAGE PRICE:**

- Pre-orientation group gathering.
- Bus transportation to and from Chicago's O'Hare airport.
- Round trip airfare from Chicago to Copenhagen and from Geiranger Norway to Chicago..
- Bus Coach transfers to and from airports and for listed itinerary sites.
- All hotel accommodations.
- Breakfasts daily and 6 dinners as shown in itinerary.
- Travel accommodations from Oslo to Bergen, either train or air.
- Experienced, licensed guides including full time Tour Escort
- All entrance fees for sites listed on itinerary.
- Tips to all step on guides and bus drivers.
- Baggage handling at hotels (one piece).
- A follow up reunion to share photos, memories and friendships will be scheduled at the conclusion of the trip.
- Valerie and Wayne's expertise and we do all the planning/scheduling, etc.

## **WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED:**

- Credit Card payments (additional 3% of the total bill)
- All Lunches & 3 dinners as listed in itinerary.
- Mandatory medical and trip cancellation insurance

## **INSURANCE:**

**Both medical and cancellation insurance are mandatory for Someday Travel Trips.**

(Travelers will need to submit a copy of the policy to Someday Travel before trip)

Someday Travel recommends Pilgrim Tour's insurance program through [\*Allianz Travel Insurance\*](#), **but travelers can purchase their insurance from whatever provider they wish.** Allianz insurance is secondary, not primary, which means costs incurred are paid by traveler upfront and bills are submitted to their primary medical insurance for reimbursement, then submitted to Allianz Insurance for anything not covered, if applicable. You should compare plans before you purchase (use benefit table listed on back of brochure). **Someday Travel requires cancellation/medical insurance for all travelers.**

Insurance cost with Allianz is 6.5% of total trip cost. **Make checks payable to Pilgrim Tours but send in to Someday Travel along with deposit and Pilgrim Reservation Form**

If you do have a **Pre-existing Medical Condition, and take Allianz, you can purchase your insurance policy any time before making you final trip payment. (However, we strongly suggest that you pay with your initial deposit). Other insurance are less relaxed on this so check with them please.**

\***Cancel for any reason**” coverage is available for 8.7% of trip cost but only refunds passengers UP TO 80% of the trip cost. Cancel for any reason insurance and regular insurance (6.5%) **MUST BE PURCHASED** at or before final trip payment...see Terms and Conditions). **(Be aware that the For any reason” option reimburses you UP TO 80% and not necessarily the full 80%, but it is your choice)**

**When talking with any insurance representative**, you should ask for coverage that has:

- Medical and cancellation component & does it cover pre-existing conditions and when your insurance policy must be purchased for your pre-existing condition to be covered.
- Ask what is covered and in what amounts (compare to Allianz Benefits).
- Important not to assume anything with insurance. Ask if they cover medical situations **in a foreign country (most US carriers don’t)** and how that is to be handled. This becomes important since Allianz is secondary so you need to know if your insurance covers any medical bills from a foreign country. If they don’t cover any, then having Allianz could be very beneficial.

**Critical Point: Most insurance carriers only allow you from 15-21 days to purchase insurance after making your initial deposit for the trip. If you have a pre-existing condition this becomes a critical thing to be aware to cover.** Feel free to call if you need any additional clarification, Valerie, 920-539-0195 or Wayne, 920-539-0085. Keep in mind that most insurance carriers require policy to be purchased within 15-21 days of when deposit is made to cover pre-existing and medical conditions.

**Someday Travel strongly recommends that all travelers purchase their insurance with their initial deposit.**

**ADDITIONAL MONEY/EXPENSES:** Travelers will be expected to bring additional sufficient funds for other expenses, such as meals not covered, souvenirs and/or other personal expenditures.

**PAYMENT and CANCELLATION POLICY:** See Pilgrim Tours Brochure for Terms and Conditions. **Please read this information carefully.** It is printed on their Reservation Form and on the back of the brochure.

**REGISTRATION/RESERVATIONS:**

To **reserve your place** on this trip, the following are required:

- **An initial deposit of \$300 per person (check payable to Pilgrim Tours)**
- **Deposit per person must accompany a Pilgrim Reservation Form. Go to [www.somedaytravel.com](http://www.somedaytravel.com) for a copy of all forms**
- **Copy of a current passport for each traveler must accompany deposit, i.e., Current means it must at least expire 6 months after last day of trip.**
- **Copy of the Someday Travel Summary Form**
- **All 4 items above need to be mailed directly to Someday Travel, PO Box 1454, Fond du Lac, WI 54936-1454.**
- **All subsequent payments are to follow the payment timetable printed in the Terms & Conditions on back of brochure and on back of Pilgrim Reservation Form and sent directly to Someday Travel but **make checks payable to Pilgrim Tours.****

**PLEASE NOTE AGAIN: ALL checks need to be made out to Pilgrim Tours. If you choose to use a credit card, be aware that there is an additional 3% fee assessed.**

**IN ADDITION to what is contained in this Someday Travel Information Form and on the Pilgrim Reservation Form, the following information needs to be mailed to SOMEDAY TRAVEL, % Valerie and Wayne Graczyk, P.O. Box 1454, Fond du Lac, WI 54936-1454. (Go to [www.somedaytravel.com](http://www.somedaytravel.com) for copy of all forms).**

\*A **recent photo of yourself**. Passport copies are not always clear enough for identification purposes and sometimes are not “current”. If the use of a picture becomes necessary for identification purposes, this extra photo becomes very important.

\*A **copy of proof of your Medical/Trip Cancellation Insurance Policy**. You should be given a medical card to carry with you during the trip. The copy of policy will be kept with Valerie and Wayne Graczyk during the entire trip.
